Summary Description:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Coordinates reportable disease investigations, infectious disease surveillance activities, community health improvement plan and community assessment activities, and epidemiologic studies. Elevates the Health Department's Epidemiology Program by cultivating surveillance opportunities, mentoring internal staff on data mining and analysis, study design, and providing community health status information. Work with Infectious Disease Team Leader to develop, implement, and evaluate program specific quantitative and qualitative work standards. Leads infectious disease investigations for the agency and assigns reportable disease investigations to other epidemiology staff under the supervision of the Team Leader. Acts as the Institutional Review Board chair for the internal Health Department committee and provides review of Health Department administered surveys for validity and consistency. Leads community meetings related to the Community Health Improvement Plan or Epidemiology related issues. Develops/selects educational and written materials for infectious disease/epidemiology programs and works with the training specialist to coordinate training/continuing education for infectious disease/epidemiology staff. Provides assistance to infectious disease/epidemiology staff to address complex problems encountered while performing disease surveillance and infectious disease investigations. Coordinates vital statistics and targeted prevention personnel by monitoring and evaluating data per program specific goals. Participate in local, regional and state emergency response teams and activities. Participates in planning, implementation, and evaluation of work processes to improve quality and efficiency of infectious disease/epidemiology programs. Represents the Health Department at meetings with community partners and participates in related collaborative initiatives as needed.

Bachelor's Degree in Public Health or related field with focus of study in Epidemiology or related area and 3 years of experience, or Master's Degree in Public Health or related field with formal training in epidemiology and 2 years of experience in Epidemiology.
