The programs included in this work unit are epidemiology, targeted prevention (investigation of new syphilis and HIV cases, identification of individuals who would benefit from STD testing due to contact with a case or risky behaviors, HIV Outreach, and STD testing) and vital statistics. The incumbent will lead planning and set goals for the programs under their purview and define action steps for meeting the goals. They will evaluate staff on the performance of their job duties related to meeting the program goals and objectives. The incumbent will also develop procedures related to work-unit functions, educate staff, and hold staff accountable for following both program and department policies and procedures.</li> </ul>

<b>Summary Description:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Performs supervisory responsibilities (3-10 employees) such as monitor, train staff, and promote teambuilding; interview, hire, assign, direct and evaluate performance of staff.</li> <li>Serve as subject matter expert and spokesperson for the department(s) supervised, as needed for press interviews and other presentations.</li> <li>Plans, operates, evaluates, and manages the infectious disease activities for the department, including epidemiology, targeted prevention (investigation of new syphilis and HIV cases, identification of individuals who would benefit from STD testing due to contact with a case or risky behaviors, HIV Outreach, linkage of HIV cases not currently receiving care to treatment resources, and STD testing) and vital statistics.</li> <li>Manages the infectious disease component of the health department including epidemiological and clinical evaluations of cases, clusters, and outbreaks of infectious disease and other conditions; collaborates with Public Health Clinic staff on investigations and to provide appropriate services to infectious disease clients.</li> <li>Serves in a leadership role in the department's Incident Command Structure to respond to communicable disease outbreaks including Covid-19.</li> </ul>
<b>Summary Requirements:</b>	Master's degree in Public Health, Public Administration or comparable field, 5 years of related experience; or PhD in Epidemiology, 4 years of experience. Must have two or more years of supervisory experience. Demonstrated ability to lead multi-disciplinary group in settings and provide leadership and guidance to positions focused on infectious disease prevention and surveillance. Related experience includes a combination of some or all of the following program areas: epidemiology, targeted disease prevention (STD), vital statistics. Background check.
