Obtain/maintain certification as a Category 8 Public Health Pesticide Operator. Completion of both the Department for Public Pesticide Operator. Completion of both the Department for Public Health Environmental and Food Core Trainings. Must be sworn in as a citation officer to enforce the "Smoking Ban" (LFUCG Ordinance-171-93) after completion of six (6) month probationary period. Requires current and valid driver's licensure and use of personal transportation to and from job assignments.</p> <p>Background check</p>
